SHEFFIELD CITY SWIMMING CLUB CHILD SAFEGUARDING PROCEDURE

Please make sure that you follow the procedures as described below, if you have an issue regarding safeguarding a child. It is everyone's responsibility to protect a child and report it to the Welfare Officer, who will deal with the concern, with the proper authorities.

Sheffield City recognises that the needs of the child are paramount, and their wellbeing comes first within the club before winning and any competitions.

- 1. All swimmers must report to their coach and parent if they have any concerns or that an incident has occurred.
- 2. The coaches will then pass this information immediately, to the Welfare Officer, only, regardless when and where it occurred.
- 3. Any parent, coach and any committee member who has concerns, <u>MUST</u> pass the information directly to the Welfare Officer only.
- 4. If for any reason that the Welfare Officer is unavailable, then your next point of contact will be our Sheffield City swimming Club Chairperson.
