Rules and Information:

- 1. The Spring Open Meet will be held under Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules of Racing and is Licensed at Level 3 (Licence Number: **3NE260019**).
- 2. The Meet will be held on Saturday 21st March 2026. The venue will be the Ponds Forge International Sports Centre, Sheaf Street, Sheffield S1 2BP
- 3. Ages are as of Saturday 21st March 2026.
- 4. The Events are:
 - 50m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle and Butterfly (Female and Open/Male) HDW
 - 100m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle and Butterfly (Female and Open/Male) HDW
 - 200m Individual Medley (Female and Open/Male) HDW
 - 400m Freestyle and 400m Individual Medley (Mixed Heats of Female and Open/Male: 11 Years+ only) HDW

"Upper Limit Times" have been applied and are published below, with any entries 'Faster Than' these times not being accepted.

- 5. The pool length is 50m and has Ten Lanes. The Pool will be equipped with an Electronic Timing System and Display Board, a Secondary Starting Strobe and Anti-Wave Lane Ropes.
- 6. Overhead starts will be used at the Promoter's and Referee's discretion and **Back Stroke Ledges will** also be used.
- 7. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
- 8. All events will be Heat Declared Winners (HDW). Medals will be presented for 1st to 6th Place for each of the listed age groups:
 - 9 Years (Female and Open/Male)
 - 10 Years (Female and Open/Male)
 - 11 Years (Female and Open/Male)
 - 12 Years (Female and Open/Male)
 - 13 Years (Female and Open/Male)
 - 14 Years (Female and Open/Male)
 - 15 Years (Female and Open/Male)
 - 16 Years and over (Female and Open/Male)
- 9. Their will be a Warm-Up / Warm-Down facility via the International Dive Pit and this will be available from the start of the competition at 9.05am. All safety guidelines must be followed as laid out by Everyone Active and the Ponds Forge Team and they reserve the right to withdraw this facility at any time to a specific swimmer, Club or to all attending swimmers, should these be repeatedly be broken.
- 10. **Top Visiting Club Award:** This will be presented at the end of the Meet, to the visiting Club that has amassed the most points across the day, with points being awarded from 1st to 6th place (e.g. 6th place = 1 point, 5th place = 2 points etc.).

- 11. The Colin Cunningham Top Open/Male and Top Female Awards: These will be presented at the end of the Meet, to the top Open/Male and top Female, who have amassed the most points across the day, with points being awarded from 1st to 6th place (e.g. 6th place = 1 point, 5th place = 2 points etc.).
- 12. Entries will be accepted on a "first-come, first-served" basis and until the capacity is reached, at which point the Meet will be declared as **FULL**.
- 13. All individual entries must be made on the official form (photocopies or scans are acceptable) and must include the swimmer's Swim England Registration Number, Age etc., together with the correct fee(s) for the race(s) entered, which can only be paid for via Bank Transfer to SCSC. Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. Entries will be accepted from the Monday 20th October 2025. No entries will be accepted after the closing date of the 22nd February 2026, or once the Meet has been declared as **FULL**, whichever comes sooner. Late entries will not be accepted, unless due to a Promoter error.
- 14. Club entries must be sent electronically via the SportSystems file set, which can be obtained directly from the Promoter via e-mail (promoter@sheffieldcityswimmingclub.co.uk) or via the Sheffield City Swimming Club website (www.sheffieldcityswimmingclub.co.uk Open Meets section). If this method is used, we only require the entry print out and payment from the club submitting the file within 14 days of confirmed acceptance. Please ensure you always enter an actual or estimated time for each swimmer, as simply putting a Yes against a swimmer will not be accepted (this allows us to correctly generate the length of both Session 1 & 2). For payment, please see the Club's Bank details below.
- 15. Submitted times should ideally be current PBs that are 'no faster' than the published Upper Limit Times, however, times **need not** be on the ASA Rankings site, as there are no Lower Limit Cut-Off's. An entry time is required, to ensure that the swimmer is not faster than the ULT (Upper Limit Time) for the respective event they have entered. Estimates are acceptable. The exception to this rule and guidance, is entry to the 400m Freestyle & 400m Individual Medley events, as all swimmers must be at least 11 Years of age, as of Saturday 21st March 2026. A submitted time MUST be accompanied by a signed declaration/or e-mail confirmation by the swimmers respective coach, stating that the swimmer is able to reasonably obtain the submitted entry time. The declaration can be sent by e-mail to: promoter@ sheffieldcityswimmingclub.co.uk Entries submitted without a declaration will not be accepted. No times will be updated after an entry has been accepted.
- 16. The competition format will be based on disability inclusion within the able-bodied programme i.e. there will be no separate events for swimmers with disabilities. All swimmers will be seeded in the heats according to their entry times. Disability competitors will be included within the results for their respective age group.
- 17. The Meet will consist of two sessions:
 - Session 1 Warm-Up 8:00am to 9.00am: Scheduled Start 9.05am Estimated Finish 12:30pm
 - Session 2 Warm-Up TO BE CONFIRMED Estimated Finish 5.50pm
- 18. If a differing number of entries are received for each session, the start time of the later session may be subject to change and will be confirmed on publication of the draft programme or via a separate communication to all clubs or individuals who have had their entry/entries accepted.
- 19. Warm-Up will be one hour prior to the start for each session and may be split into gender and age groups (This will be confirmed and communicated by the promoter, nearer to the event date).

- 20. Warm-Up will be one hour prior to the start for each session and may be split into gender and age groups (This will be confirmed and communicated by the promoter, nearer to the event date).
- 21. The Entry Fee is £9.00 per event.
- 22. Each Club will have an allocated space within the seating section, which will be based on their total number of entries.
- 23. A Poolside Pass will cost £7.00 for a single session, or £12.00 for the day (An All-Day Pass also includes a Buffet Lunch). Please indicate the number of relevant Poolside Passes required on the **Cash Summary Form** and these must be paid for as part of the submitted total payment, from each respective club that is attending and who have had their entry file(s) accepted by SCSC. As required, each person who will utilise a Poolside Pass and whose name and position has been supplied on the Cash Summary Form, are by default being confirmed by the respective Club whose entries have been accepted, that each person holds a valid DBS and Bar check through the relevant Club. be confirmed by e-mail, along with the Cash Summary promoter@sheffieldcityswimmingclub.co.uk
- 24. Spectator admission prices:
 - For a Single Session: Adult £6.00, Child (6-16 Years) & OAP's (60+ Years) £4.00
 - All Day (Sessions 1 & 2): Adult £10.00, Child (6-16 Years) & OAP's (60+ Years) £6.00
 - Under 6's will be Free, but they may not be able to occupy a seat, should the spectator capacity be reached
- 25. A draft programme, with details of all the accepted swimmers and their relevant entries, will be sent directly to each attending Club/Individual via e-mail and this will also be available on the Sheffield City website, prior to the event. This is to allow and enable, parents, carers and swimmers to check their entries and advise SCSC of any discrepancies.
- 26. Swimmers will be called, prior to their event and heat, and should report to the relevant Swim Marshalls immediately. Swimmers will be placed in Heat and Lane order within the preparation seating area, before being directed to the starting area by the relevant Swim Marshalls.
- 27. Please help the running of the meet by advising us of withdrawals, where known. A Withdrawal deadline will be sent to all attending Clubs/Individuals prior to the start of the Meet. The mechanism for any withdrawals will be via e-mail to Lee Day at:

 No refunds will be made after their entry or entries have been accepted by SCSC or after the closing date.

- 29. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at the Ponds Forge International Sports Centre and must wear suitable footwear and clothing when leaving the Poolside.
